ABOUT THE DIRECTORS

Head Coach Barbara Stevens is in her 23rd season as women's basketball coach at Bentley University and has compiled a 753-212 record in that time...2006 inductee Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, 3 time WBCA National Division II Coach of the Year, 12 time NE-10 Coach of the Year...Guided Bentley to the NCAA Division II Final Four five consecutive seasons from 1989-1993, and again in 1997 and 2003.

Assistant Coach C. White is a 2001 graduate of Bentley and was a four-year letter winner for the Falcons. She is in her 6th season as Coach Stevens' top assistant. She was an assistant coach at Harvard prior to returning to Bentley.

Assistant Dan Hunt is in his first season with the Bentley women's basketball program. Prior to coming to Bentley, he served as an assistant coach at Northeastern University and head coach at Lesley College and Lasell College.

STAFF

The staff will consist of outstanding college and high school coaches from the New England region and will be assisted by quality players from top college programs. They are excellent teachers of the game and are genuinely concerned for the overall development of each camper. Player to staff ratio is approximately seven to one.
