

My Rights Under Title IX

I have the right to

live and learn at Bentley University free from harassment or discrimination based on my sex, gender, and/or gender appearance.

I have the right to

file a complaint according to Bentley's Title IX and Gender-Based Discrimination Policy. I also have the right to request a criminal investigation with law enforcement.

I have the right to

know and understand the different types of employees at Bentley, meaning who is confidential and who is not.

I have the right to

understand that Bentley is required to undertake a prompt and thorough investigation of all reports of gender- and sex-based misconduct.

I have the right to

interim support and reasonable protective measures to help me continue to live and learn at Bentley, for instance a housing or academic modification.

I have the right to

be free from retaliation for exercising my rights.
