

Liberal Arts/Interdisciplinary

Under the rubric of Liberal Arts, students may design

- a single concentration in a discipline such as behavioral sciences, economics, English, government, law, mathematical sciences, modern languages, or natural sciences; or
- an interdisciplinary concentration in areas such as communication, environmental sciences, gender studies, interpersonal and social relations, and legal studies.

Students will work with the coordinator and faculty advisors from appropriate departments to construct a major within the framework of the Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Arts.

- BA students may take only 30 credits in a business discipline including the courses from the Business Studies Major or minor.
- Liberal Arts Majors may elect to also complete a Business Studies Major or Business Studies minor, but are not required to do so.
