Actuarial Science

The Actuarial Science degree prepares you for a rewarding career in the actuarial field. Actuaries are in great demand by the insurance, financial services and consulting industries. Graduates are recruited for leadership development in top insurance companies.

An Actuarial Science major can provide extensive preparation for four actuarial exams (Exams P/1, FM/2, MLC and MFE/3F) as well all of the necessary VEE (Validation by Educational Experience) credit. In addition, qualified students will have the opportunity to pursue an internship in actuarial science.
